



Terms & Conditions

By registering for Poznań Model United Nations 2017 (hereafter referred to as POZMUN 2017 or the Conference) and using this website, you are deemed to have read and agreed to the following terms and conditions:

General Rules

1. English shall be the only used language at the POZMUN 2017 conference.
2. All registered Delegates must be enrolled in high school or university at the time of the POZMUN 2017 conference
3. All Delegates under the age of 18 years are advised to be accompanied by a supervisor. Teachers, parents, university students and other individuals of 18 years or older are eligible to be a supervisor.
4. POZMUN 2017 will not tolerate any instances of harassment or discrimination, including but not limited to those based on race, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, age, religion or disability. Furthermore, POZMUN 2017 will not tolerate any instances of inappropriate behavior or unwelcome advances of a sexual nature. If any, delegate, staff, supervisor believes that they have encountered harassment or discrimination, which results in a hostile working environment or disparate treatment, they are encouraged to bring it on to the attention of the Secretary-General or another member of the Secretariat who will have the authority expel a Delegate from the POZMUN 2017 if such punishment is considered appropriate.
5. All Delegates are required to avoid actions which can pose risk to safety at the Conference.
6. All Delegates must abide by the Rules of Procedure during the General Assembly and the Committee Sessions. Should a Delegate fail to comply with the Rules of Procedure, her/his participation in the Conference may be limited at the discretion of the Secretary General, the President of the General Assembly or the Delegate's Chair.
7. All Delegates must dress in Western Business Attire (WBA) while at POZMUN 2017. As a general rule, WBA requires that delegates dress in a suit jacket, slacks or skirt, dress shirt with tie, and dress shoes. National attire is also permitted. If a delegate's attire is deemed inappropriate by the Secretariat, the delegate will be asked to leave the session and return with appropriate attire. Clothes that expose excessive bare skin or are otherwise revealing are deemed inappropriate.
8. Delegates are expected to arrive on time at the Conference, this includes the Opening Ceremony, the General Assembly and the Committee Sessions. Failing to arrive on time may limit Delegate's participation in the Conference.

9. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, the Delegate recognizes that the organisers of POZMUN 2017 shall have a right to publish and distribute any photos or movies taken during the Conference, even if they include an image of the Delegate.

Registration & Payment

10. The registration is conducted via MyMun.net platform. The Delegates must possess a free account on mymun.net to be able to register.
11. All Delegates are obliged to pay a fee of 25 euros . The fee is requested within 9 days after being accepted to the conference. If this period is exceeded, Delegate's assignment might not be given upon his/her preferences.
12. The Conference fee is non-refundable. If the Delegate cancels his/her participation in the Conference for any reason after transferring the fee, the organisers of POZMUN 2017 will not be able to return the fee. If the Delegate is expelled from the Conference for breaking Terms & Conditions, or if his/her participation in the Conference is limited, the fee will not be returned.
13. Organisers of POZMUN 2017 cannot guarantee that every Delegate receives a post in accordance with his/her declared preferences.
14. Only after submitting a bank transfer confirmation to the organisers of POZMUN 2017 is the Delegate's post at the Conference certain. Before paying the fee, the Delegates are asked to wait for an e-mail confirming their successful registration.

Liability

15. During the Conference, all the Delegates are obliged to abide by Polish law.
16. No alcohol is allowed during the Conference, except for the Social Event, when the alcohol is allowed for individuals who are at least 18 years old (according to Polish legal policies).
17. Delegates are required to obey the Intellectual Property laws at all times during the Conference.
18. Delegates are personally responsible for all charges and damages to the venues of the Conference, this including Social Events venues.
19. The Delegates are obliged to follow the rules of the venues, where the conference and social event are taking place- Browar Pub Słodownia on Półwiejska Street 42 and Collegium Iuridicum Novum on Niepodległości Avenue 53.
20. POZMUN 2017 organisers do not take any responsibility for the Delegates' damaging actions or breaking of any laws.

Final provisions

21. The Secretary General of POZMUN 2017 can modify the Terms & Conditions at any time (excluding provisions regarding the Conference fee).
22. The President of General Assembly can modify the Rules of Procedure at any time.
23. All the information published on www.pozmun.pl, including the Conference Agenda, is subject to change.
